**EDUCATIONAL NOTICE**

**ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION INTO B.Sc. NURSING COURSE IN BOTH THE GOVT. AND PRIVATE INSTITUTES OF ASSAM FOR THE SESSION 2024**

In pursuance of the Assam Gazette Notification No. MER. 206054/786 dated 07-11-2023, the Entrance Examination for selection of candidates for admission into B.Sc. Nursing Course in both the Govt. and Private Institutes of Assam for the session 2024 is going to be held on **09-06-2024**. Online Application Forms shall be available on University website: **www.ssuhs.in** from **09-05-2024** to **24-05-2024**. The online application Form must be filled up after carefully going through the instructions given along with the Form.

The requisite entrance examination fee (non-refundable) shall have to be paid by the candidates only in online mode through the payment gateway available in the University website (Fee Collect). The details of categories of fee are available in the University website along with other details of examination. Above Examination fee is exempted for PwD (Divyang) category of candidates having disability of 40% and above.


Details of the Entrance Examination including eligibility criteria and requirements are available at the University website: **www.ssuhs.in**.

The Entrance Test is going to be held on **09-06-2024** at Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur, Kokrajhar, Shillong, Aizawl, Itanagar, Agartala, Imphal, Dimapur and Gangtok. Finalization of examination centres in the state capitals of other North Eastern states will depend on the number of applicants applying for respective state capitals for appearing in the examination.

Admit Cards will be available online at **www.ssuhs.in** from **03-06-2024** which can be downloaded after log in.

Candidates are strictly advised to keep record of the Application Number and Password used by them while submitting the online form, without which they will not be able to download Admit Cards.

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**DETAILS OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR  
ADMISSION INTO B.Sc. NURSING COURSE IN BOTH THE GOVT. AND PRIVATE  
INSTITUTES OF ASSAM FOR THE SESSION 2024.**

1. The Entrance Examination shall be held on **09-06-2024 (From 11.00AM to 1.00 PM)**
2. There shall be 1 (one) paper consisting of 100 objective type Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) for Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.
3. Questions will be of HS (10+2) Science standard.
4. Distribution of marks will be: Physics – 25 marks, Chemistry – 25 marks, Biology (Zoology and Botany) – 25 marks and English – 25 marks.
5. Merit shall be prepared based on the total marks obtained by each candidate in all the subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English. The marks obtained by each candidate in each subject shall also be shown in the said list.

If two or more candidates secure the same marks in the Entrance Examination, the inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows:

- a. Candidate securing more marks in Biology in Entrance Examination.
  - b. Candidates securing more marks in Chemistry in Entrance Examination.
  - c. Candidates securing more marks in Physics in Entrance Examination
  - d. Candidates securing more marks in English in Entrance Examination
  - e. If it further tallies then marks obtained in Biology, then Chemistry, then Physics, then English of qualifying examination shall be considered at the time of counselling.
6. The minimum qualifying criteria/cut off score in the Entrance Examination of B.Sc. Nursing Course will be as follows:
    - a. General (UR/EWS) – 50<sup>th</sup> Percentile
    - b. SC/ST/OBC – 40<sup>th</sup> Percentile
    - c. UR – PWD – 45<sup>th</sup> Percentile
  7. If seats remain vacant, the minimum percentile will be reassessed by the Govt. of Assam/ Directorate of Medical Education, Assam before second counselling.

8. The Entrance Examination will be conducted in the following zones:

Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur, Kokrajhar, Shillong, Aizawl, Itanagar, Agartala, Imphal, Dimapur, Gangtok

However, final decision regarding holding of the Entrance Examination in the above zones will be taken in due course of time depending on the number of candidates applying for respective zones for appearing in the examination.

**The eligibility criteria for appearing in the entrance test and for admission into B.Sc. Nursing Course are as follows:**

9. Applicant must be a citizen of India.


10. Candidate must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Science or Equivalent Examination from recognized Board/Council/University with English as one of the subjects and securing at least 50% marks aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology for General Category candidates, 45% for PwD Candidates and 40% for candidates belonging to SC/ST(P)/ST(H) category without grace marks.

11. Candidate must be minimum of 17 years on 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which admission is sought.

**Reservation of seat:** There shall be reservation of seats for SC/ST(P)/ST(H)/OBC/MOBC/TGL/Ex-TGL/EWS/PwD (Divyang) category from the available seats as per Govt norms. However, the distribution, reservation of seats and admission including management quota shall be notified by Directorate of Medical Education, Assam in due course of time.

A non-refundable examination fee of **Rs. 1500/- (Rupees Fifteen hundred only)** is required to be paid by General category candidates and **Rs.1200/- (Rupees Twelve hundred only)** by candidates belonging to SC/ ST / EWS/ OBC (NCL)/MOBC etc. including TGL/Ex-TGL category candidates through the Payment gateway available on online application page and University website ([www.ssuhs.in](http://www.ssuhs.in)> Fee collect> Student Category > Entrance Examination Fee> B.Sc. Nursing).

**IMPORTANT:** It is the responsibility of the applicant to furnish all information correctly. Any information given by the applicant if found to be false or any ineligibility criteria detected at any stage later on shall make him/her liable to be disqualified from the Entrance Examination with all its associated consequences.



A candidate who desires to be considered under reserve category shall have to furnish original certificate of the concerned category from the Competent Authority at the time of Counselling.

A candidate applying under PwD (Divyang) Category will have to produce applicable Certificate from the State Level Medical Board/District Level Medical Board as constituted in pursuance of Social Welfare Departments Notification No. SWD.181/96/75 dated 21-06-1990.

**As the form is to be submitted online, the candidates are not required to send any document to the University. All necessary verification/scrutiny of the related documents of the candidates regarding eligibility, reservation etc. will be done at the time of counselling by the concerned authority.**
